You have to believe that but they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint. Isaiah 40:31

You have to believe that for it is by grace you have been saved, through faith--and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—Ephesian 2:8

You have to believe that for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.” Hebrew 11:6

You have to believe that in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us. Roman 8:37

You have to believe that thanks *be* to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. First Corinthians 15:57

You have to believe that you can do all things through Christ who strengthen you. Philippians 4:13

You have to believe that nothing will ever separate you from the love of God. Roman 8:31-39

You have to believe that that your body is the temple of the Lord. First Corinthians 6:19-20

You have to believe that you are the righteousness of God in Jesus Christ. First Corinthians 5:21

You have to believe that the blessings of God maketh us rich and it add no sorrow to it. Proverb 10:22

You have to believe that every crooked road is being made straight in your life and in the life of your loved ones. Isaiah 40:4

You have to believe that we all have a gift and purpose from God. Roman 12:6

You have to believe that if you confess your sins he is faithful and just to forgive you of all your sins. First John 1:9

You have to believe that your sins are forgiven as you forgive others of their sins against you. Matthews 6:12

You have to believe that I am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more. Isaiah 43:25

You have to believe that your prayers are being heard by God. Psalm 66:19

You have to believe that you are the head and not the tail, that you are above and not beneath. Deuteronomy 28:13

You have to believe that you are blessed in the city and blessed in the field and that your barns are running over so that you can be a blessing to someone else. Deuteronomy 28:3

You have to believe that you are maturing and becoming like Jesus Christ day by day.

You have to believe that we wrestle not against flesh and blood (**people**), but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Ephesian 6:12

You have to believe that no weapon formed against you shall not prosper; in your life, in your finances and in your loved ones lives. Isaiah 43:25

You have to believe that when God is for you he is more than the world against you. Roman 8:31

You have to believe that Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Proverb 22:6-8

You have to believe that God is married to the backslider.
Jeremiah 3:14

If you are sick in your body- **You have to believe that** you are healed. [Isaiah 53:5] But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. {So take your medicine and pray over it so it will do what it is designed to do}.

If you are struggling- **You have to believe that** whom the Son has set free is free indeed. John 8:36 [Allow the Holy Spirit to lead and guide you through the deliverances] [If he tells you not to do something then don't do it] [If he tells you to do something then do it] [But make sure it is the Holy Spirit] [He will never tell you to do evil, or go against the law, or against the word of God and/or your will].

In closing the ending [2 Corinthians 1:20-22]-**For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. And so through him the "Amen" is spoken by us to the glory of God. ²¹Now it is God who makes both us and you stand firm in Christ. He anointed us, ²²set his seal of ownership on us, and put his Spirit in our hearts as a deposit, guaranteeing what is to come.**
